A few simple changes can make all the difference when it comes to using less energy and lowering energy bills at home. The Energy Conservation Assistance Program is designed to help households on a limited budget make these changes for FREE.

Home Energy Evaluation

An evaluator will work with you to find simple ways to improve your home's energy efficiency at no cost to you.

Energy upgrades

They will identify the best opportunities for savings, and install products* like:

- > Energy-saving light bulbs
- > High-efficiency showerheads and faucet aerators
- > Door weatherstripping
- > Wrap for hot water pipes
- > LED nightlight

Some homes may even qualify for an ENERGY STAR® fridge, insulation in walls, attics and/or crawlspaces, and a high-efficiency gas furnace.


The evaluator will show you other ways to save and how to get the most from your new upgrades.

Check the chart inside to see if you qualify.

*Products installed depend on the individual characteristics of the home and other program criteria. Only BC Hydro electrically-heated or FortisBC natural gas-heated single family houses, townhouses and duplexes are eligible for insulation upgrades. In addition, FortisBC natural gas-heated homes must also meet consumption thresholds to qualify for insulation or furnace replacement. Other program criteria apply. Apartment units, mobile homes and homes with other heating fuel types are not eligible for insulation or furnaces. Offer subject to change.

Am I eligible?

You are eligible* if

- > You own or rent a detached house, duplex, townhouse or mobile home
- > You have a BC Hydro residential account in your name
- > The combined annual, before-tax income for all adults in the home (over 18 years) is the same or less than the amounts shown:

Number of people living in the home	Before-tax annual household income
1 person	\$32,000
2 persons	\$39,800
3 persons	\$48,900
4 persons	\$59,400
5 persons	\$67,400
6 persons	\$76,000
7 or more persons	\$84,600

Apply and start saving

How to apply

- > Visit bchydro.com/ecap to apply
- > Income qualifications: Submit a Notice of Assessment for each person living in the home over 18 years of age. For other options visit bchydro.com/ecap.
- > If you're renting, ask your landlord to complete the Landlord Consent Form

You will be contacted within six weeks of submitting your completed application. If you have qualified for the program you will be scheduled for your FREE home energy evaluation.
